



FY19 Project and Technical Assistance Grants

Breckenridge Creative District - To build on next steps from previous years evaluation project which will be focused on public outreach around a project entitled "Ecoventions Breckenridge" to bolster advocacy, dialogue, story-sharing, civic application, and cross-section innovation. Ecoventions Breckenridge is an outdoor series of 3 public artworks, each created by an environmental artist during a 4-6 week residency at the Breckenridge Arts District.

Corazon de Trinidad Creative District – Support for long range collaborative planning between the town and creative district along with website updates.

Crested Butte Creative District – Support for the Town Park Sculpture Garden and Music Path, a collaborative partnership between the Crested Butte Creative District, Town of Crested Butte, and Crested Butte Center for the Arts to enhance the sense of place in the Creative District by creating new public art that provides an opportunity for local artists to showcase their work, encourages walkability throughout the Town, inspires youth engagement with the arts, and helps anchor the new Center for the Arts building in the heart of the Creative District.

Downtown Colorado Springs Creative District – Support for the production of 12 new works of small-scale public sculpture in 2019 as part of its ArtSpot art-in-flowerpots program. ArtSpot sculptures are intended to deter vandalism and provide eye-level, arm's-reach creative interactions for pedestrians specifically. ArtSpot is the only sculpture program in Colorado Springs that specifically celebrates and compensates the work of local artists who may not have the production capacity to participate in larger public art programs like Art on the Streets.

Downtown Fort Collins Creative District - For a one-year effort to build the local and regional connections that foster collaboration, community and partnerships while undertaking creatively-developed and creative-focused activities. Includes professional development, start-up resources and placemaking activities connected with strategic goals.

Mancos Creative District – Town on Mancos Wayfinding signage celebrating and honoring the cultural heritage of the Mancos valley.

Manitou Springs Creative District – Support for the city-wide Signage and Manitou Made: Shop Local/Locally Made Program

Paonia Creative District – Fabrication and installation of gateway wayfinding signage and murals outlined in the wayfinding and signage plan.



Pueblo Creative Corridor – To support traffic box wraps designed by local artists for 18 boxes and a structural engineering study for Arts Alliance Studios building facade, to match a Colorado State Historic Fund Grant.

Ridgway Creative District - The Ridgway Creative District will energize and engage the local community through the creation and integration of a piece of artwork initially installed on the Ridgway Space to Create lot and eventually incorporated into the long-term affordable live/work facility to be built on the municipally-owned lot.

Steamboat Springs Creative District - Support for acquisition of First Friday Artwalk (FFAW) program, program re-design, re-branding and expansion of represented art forms and acquisition of Center for Visual Arts (CVA) as well as relocation of core CVA artists to the historic Depot Art Center.

Westwood Creative District - Support for the creation of a logo for the Westwood Creative District, supporting partners to include art into their projects and creating unique expressions of the Westwood Creative District on district banners, a mural selfie station and through a wayfinding installation created by local artists
